PURPOSE:

To help defray the cost for professional development by individuals who cannot attend financial aid conferences and training seminars because of budgetary constraints.

To recognize Mr. Mack C. Adams, who served the financial aid profession for 39 years. Mr. Adams began his career in student financial assistance at Southern Methodist University, serving from 1956 -1971 as the Director of Special Services, which included responsibility as Coordinator of Student Financial Aid. Mr. Adams served as Assistant Commissioner for Student Services for the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board from 1971 until his retirement in July of 1995. In this office, he held responsibility for all of the State's student financial aid and related programs, which numbered about thirty-eight.

CRITERIA:

The Scholarship Committee will consider budgetary constraints, individual desire for professional growth, job responsibilities in relation to program agenda and previous institutional scholarships received. All applicants must be TASFAA members with current membership dues paid in full.

AMOUNT:

Scholarship recipients will receive \$200 to be applied toward workshop registration fees. The scholarship does not cover expenses for lodging outside the conference hotel. A free shuttle from the DFW Airport to the conference hotel is provided. Rental car expenses will not be reimbursed by TASFAA.
